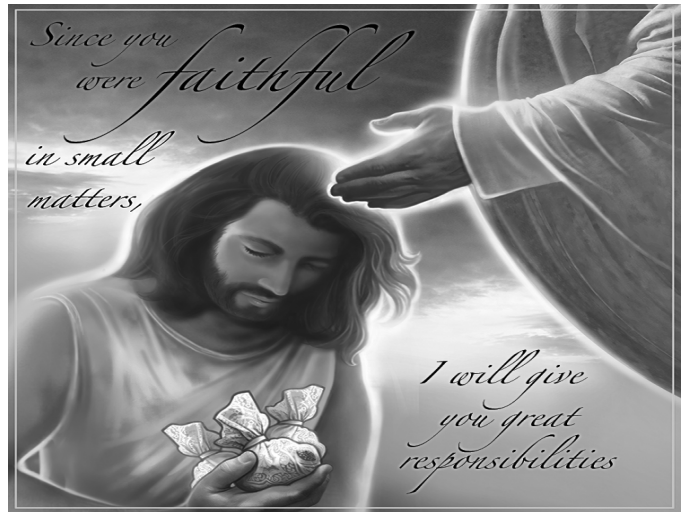

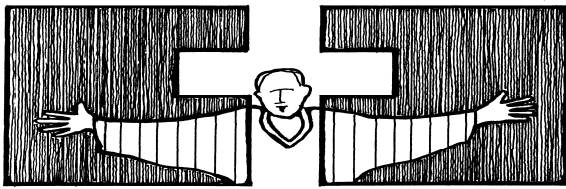

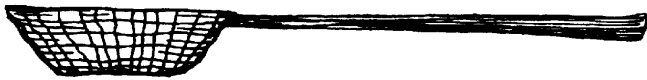

Same Sunday last year was \$ 9,541.21.

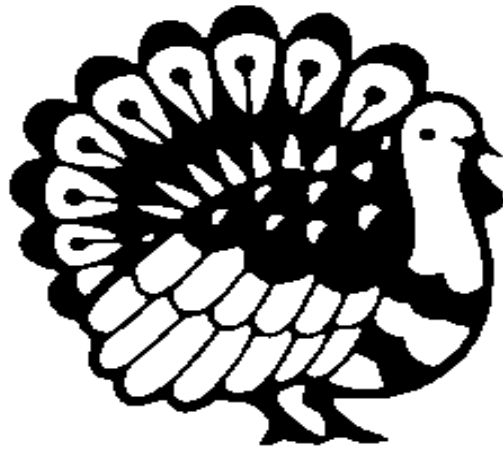
